Open and Closed Syllables; Review Long u

Focus

- Long vowels sound like their names.
- Long u can be spelled *_ew*, *_ue*, *u*, and *u_e*.
- Open syllables end in a vowel sound. The vowel sound is usually long.
- Closed syllables end in a vowel followed by a consonant. The vowel sound is usually short.
